RITCHEY HONORED WITH AMERICAN MUNICIPAL POWER-DNA AWARD

- Annual award recognizes outstanding employee

COLUMBUS: Karen Ritchey was recognized May 31 as American Municipal Power's (AMP) 2013 "AMP DNA Award" recipient. Ritchey is manager of communications programs, and has been with the Columbus-based organization since 2005.

Marc Gerken, AMP president/CEO initiated the annual award in 2008 to recognize an employee who advances AMP's vision and mission as established through its strategic planning process. AMP's vision is "To be public power's leader in wholesale energy supply," and its mission is "To develop, manage and supply diverse, competitively priced, reliable wholesale energy to public power through strategic partnerships and member-focused relationships."

To accomplish its vision and mission, AMP employees must believe in, and demonstrate, the core values of the organization: cooperation, integrity, innovation, action-oriented, effective communication and member focused. These values serve as the

organization's "DNA" and are a critical foundation to its ability to succeed and serve member communities. "Karen received multiple nominations from across AMP's departments," Gerken said. "She is dependable, efficient and always tries to lift the spirits of those around her.
